

LAS HUESTES DEL CADÍ in Elda is pleased to announce the XLI CERTAMEN INTERNACIONAL DE MINICUADROS according to the rules below:

**THIS YEAR THERE IS A NEW PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION, PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING POINTS:**

**1.** Any artist of any nationality will be allowed to participate.

**2.** The following prizes will be awarded:

- Premio CADÍ, worth €1,500
- Premio LIBERTAD, worth €1,000
- Premio CARTONAJES SALINAS, worth €1,000
- Premio GRÁFICAS MIGER, worth €1,000

In addition, any accessits with no financial supplement could be given if the judges see fit. The money prizes will be subject to the provisions of current legislation on income tax retention.

**3.** Both technique and subject are not restricted. Every artist will be allowed to present two works of art at most.

**4.** Each side of the work of art must not be greater than 25 cm. long, including its frame. Paintings will be presented on an adequate support, preferably no glass.

**5.** Works will be accepted from the publication of these rules on Thursday, February 6, until 2 p.m. on Friday, April 3, 2020.

**6.** In order to participate in the contest it is necessary to follow the following steps carefully:

**REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**

Registration will be done electronically. Artists must correctly fill out the form available on our website [www.huestesdelcadi.es](http://www.huestesdelcadi.es) as well as on the competition's social media profiles on Instagram and Facebook. After indicating their contact details, address and artwork details, they may attach a photo and/or video of the work if necessary.

The members of the jury will make a selection of 100 works through the images attached by the artists.

**7.** The artistic direction of the contest will contact each selected artist to inform them about the sending of their work from Wednesday 8th April to Thursday 23rd April.

The members of the jury will make the decision in person with the pre-selected works.

The 100 works pre-selected by the jury must be sent in secure packaging, prepaid, or delivered personally to the following address:

**8.** Of all the works of art received within the period mentioned in the previous point, the Jury designated by the artistic direction of the competition will make a selection of works, to which they will award prizes and accessits. All of them will be included in a catalogue and in the programmed exhibitions.

**9.** The jury will consist of experts and qualified people in the world of art of recognized prestige at national and international level.

**10.** At the beginning of March, the names of the specialists who will be part of the 2020 jury will be published on the website [www.huestesdelcadi.es](http://www.huestesdelcadi.es).

**11.** The decision of the judges will be unopen to appeal, and it will be published on [www.huestesdelcadi.es](http://www.huestesdelcadi.es) from April 27th, as well as the list of the admitted artists and that of selected works.

**12.** The prizes will be awarded to the winners. If their permanent address is located in Spain, they are obliged to attend the inauguration of the exhibition. It will take place at the Museo del Calzado in Elda, on Saturday, May 23rd at 12 p.m. The selected pieces will be exhibited in the Exhibition Hall of the Museo del Calzado from May 25th to June 20th 2020.

The dates of the exhibitions of the works planned after the one held at the Museo del Calzado will be published on the website [www.huestesdelcadi.es](http://www.huestesdelcadi.es) in March.

**13.** The chosen work of art for the Premio Cadí will become the property of Comparsa Huestes del Cadí. The chosen works for the rest of the Awards -Libertad, Cartonajes Salinas and Miger- will become the property of their sponsors respectively.

**14.** The pieces which have not been selected and whose artists opt to collect them, either personally or by means of someone authorised, will be available from May 23rd to August 31st 2020. The artists who prefer their pieces to be returned by postal service or courier will pay them on delivery as soon as they have received them by the month of July. The selected pieces will be available for the artists to collect only after all the exhibitions have ended.

**15.** The pieces sent to their artists and given back for any reason to the organizers of the contest will automatically become the property of Comparsa Huestes del Cadí after three months' time.

**16.** The organizers guarantee the maximum care in the treatment and custody of the pieces during the time that they are in their possession, declining all responsibility for any damage or losses that may occur. As such, the artists are resigned to make no claims from the organizers for any such eventualities.

**17.** Participation in the contest implies total acceptance and conformity with the guidelines presented herein.

**18.** In compliance with that set forth in the Spanish Organic Law 15/1999 on Personal Data Protection, you are informed that the data collected in this form will become part of an automated file and duly registered in the Register of the Spanish Agency for Data Protection, owned by the Comparsa Huestes del Cadí and will be used exclusively for necessary purpose related to the contest. If you disagree with any of the points mentioned above, please inform us with a written statement. Otherwise, we will understand your agreement to the use previously mentioned.
